Corona Awareness Programme

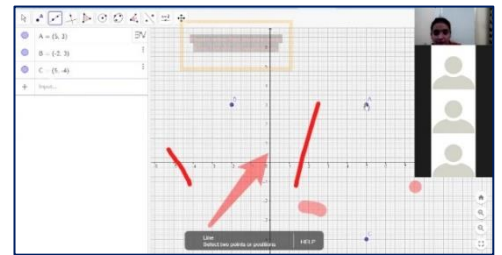
“Surely we will win against corona virus”

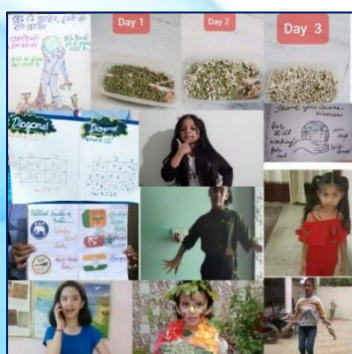


Online PTM

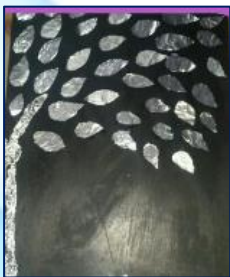
Raising Readers

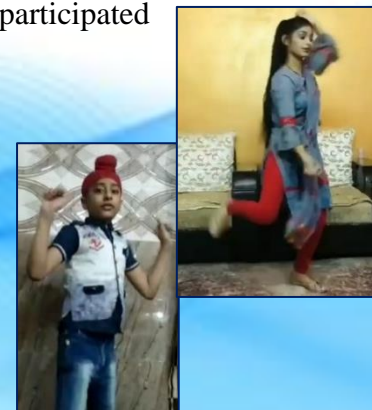


Father's Day Activity
