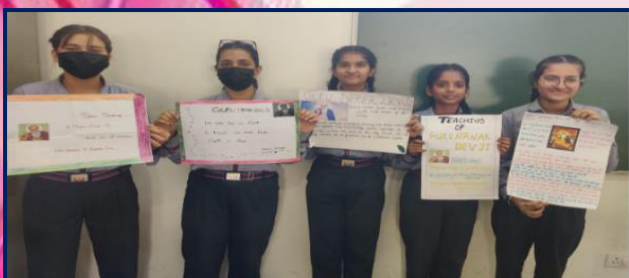
## DIWALI CELEBRATION
