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GANDHI JAYANTI CELEBRATION

DEWORMING CAMPAIGN

Soil Transmitted Helminthes (STH) is a significant public health concern for India. Around 22 crore Indian children aged 1-14 are estimated to be at risk of worm infections. Worms in children interfere with nutrient uptake, and can contribute to anemia, malnourishment, and impaired mental and physical development.



To combat this issue, in 2015 the Government of India launched the fixed-day anganwadi and school-based National Deworming Day to deworm all children aged 1-19 years.

On October 11th and 12th, 2023, the students of class Nursery to XII were given Albendazol tablets in a pre-defined manner.

GLOBAL HANDWASHING DAY

Global Handwashing Day is observed every year on October 15. The day is dedicated to create awareness about the role of handwashing in preventing several microbial diseases. Celebrating Handwashing Day on a global level is an opportunity to educate masses about the significant role of washing hands with soap and water in preventing the spread of germs, and associated diseases. On this day, the students were motivated and guided to wash hands properly. They were also told to make posters related to it. It was great learning experience for the students and they enjoyed this activity a lot.



WORLD FOOD DAY
