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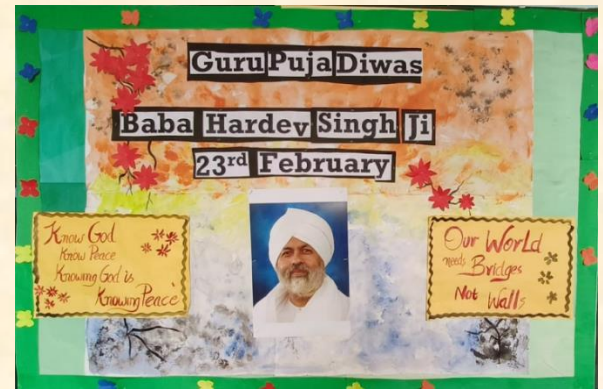
EK BHARAT SHRESHTHA BHARAT: ART EXHIBITION

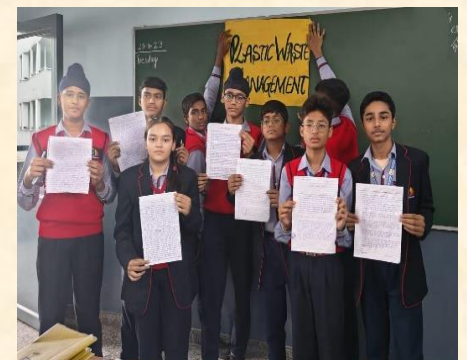
GURU PUJA DIWAS

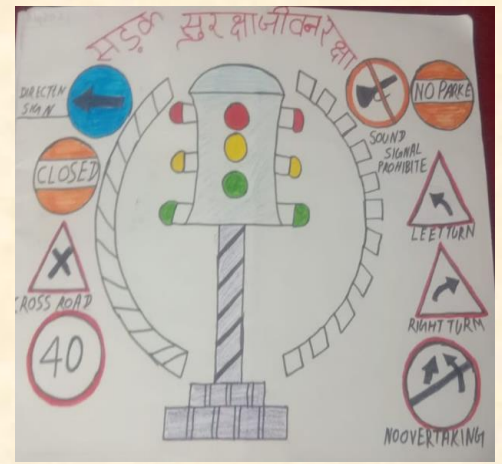
PLASTIC WASTE MANAGEMENT

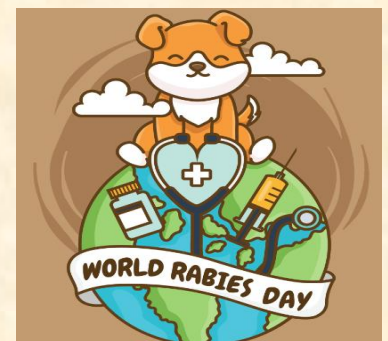
INTERNATIONAL MOTHER LANGUAGE DAY
