LABOUR DAY



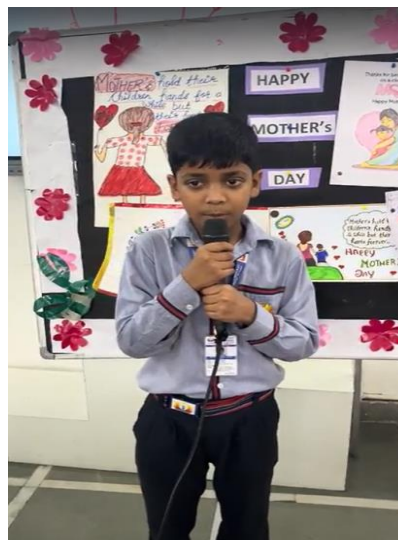

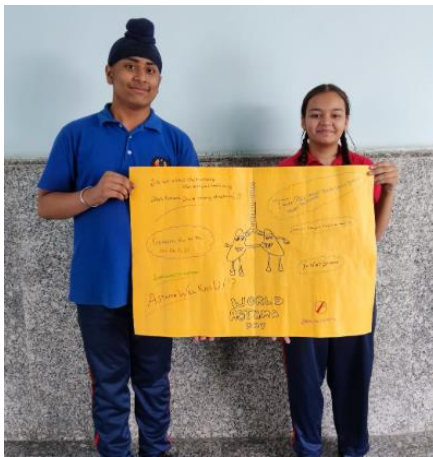
LAUGHTER DAY

CBSE SCIENCE CHALLENGE

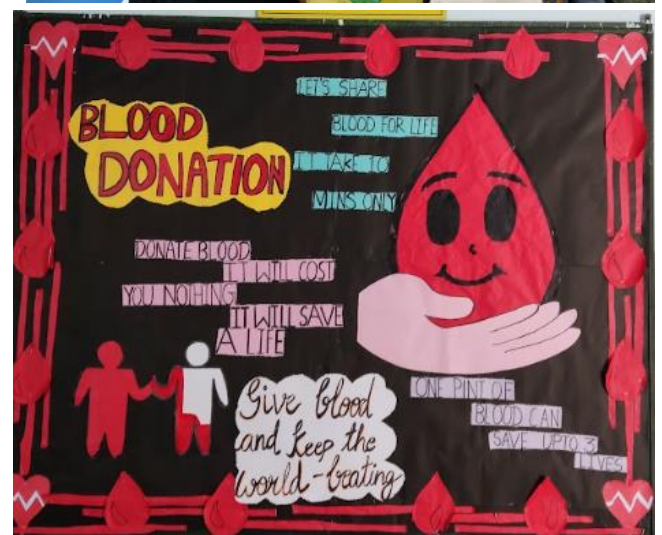

CBSE EXPRESSION SERIES

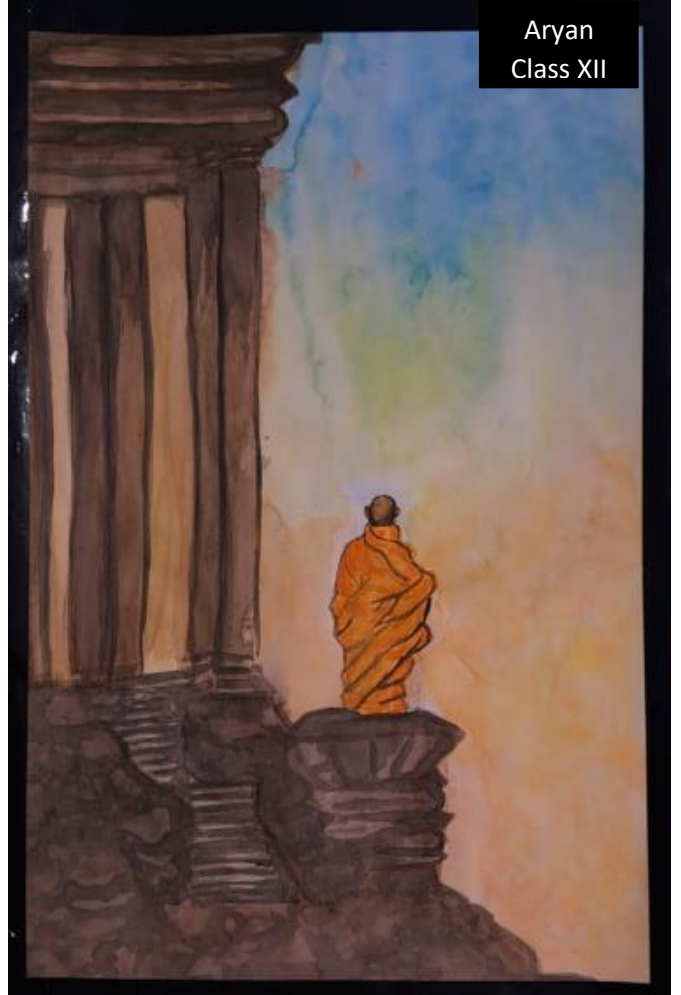
