



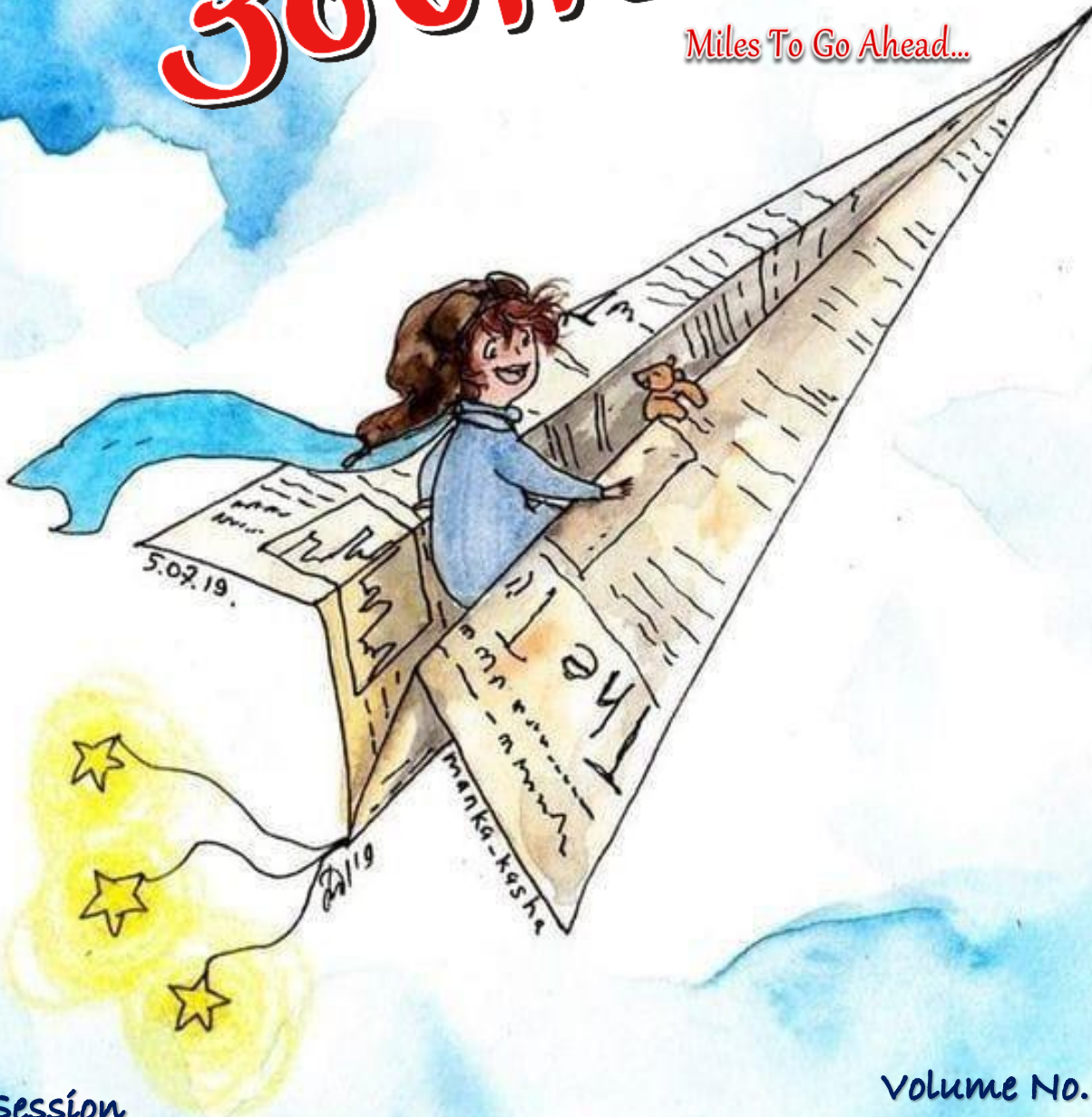

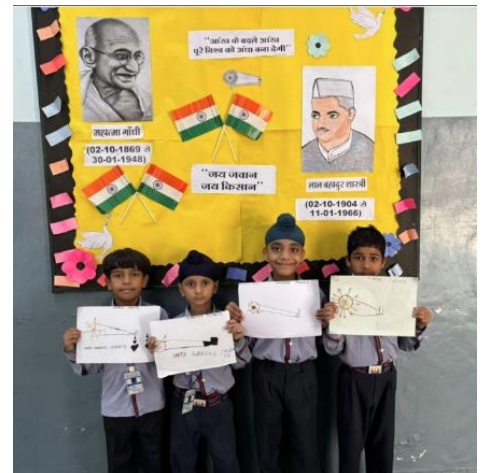
Overall Activities

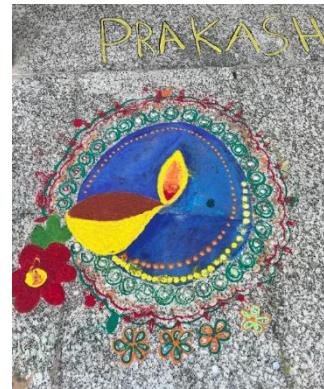
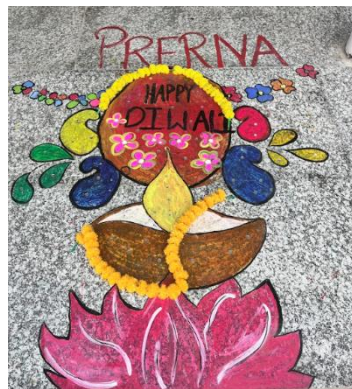
Preet House: Indian Lady (Depiction of Indian Culture) – Secured First Position

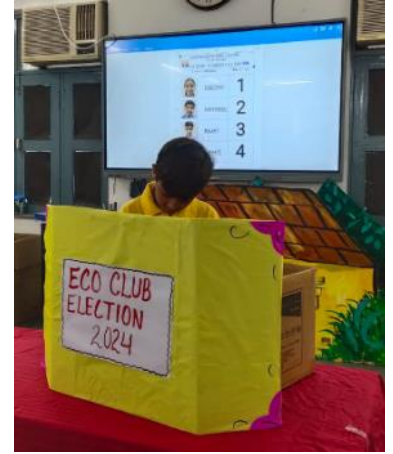

WORKSHOP ON STRESS MANAGEMENT

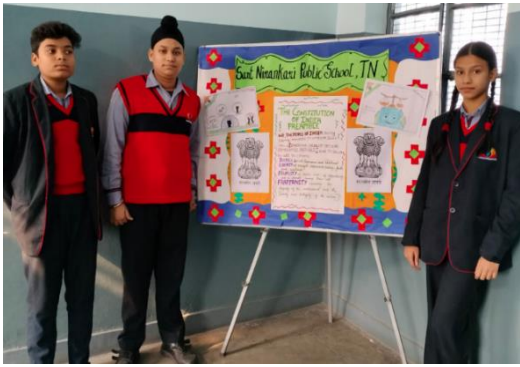
